### New workplace

The office tower on 71 Robinson Road is situated between McCallum Street and Maxwell Link, not far from the heart of the Central Business District in Singapore. It is an important contribution to the cityscape, and an enhancement of the urban fabric, especially with respect to the city's future growth towards Marina Bay.

The unique and elegant character of the office building is defined by lightness, transparency and openness. The offices have the highest levels of flexibility, efficiency and ecological sustainability. The office floors have a clear floor-to-ceiling height of three metres. The floor plates can be subdivided for up to four tenants per floor. The all-glass façades increase the amount of daylight that can reach deep into the building and lower the need for artificial light and air-conditioning.
