The city centre of Chemnitz has been undergoing a process of change based on a new town plan since the 1990s. The seed corn of this rebuilding is the new market in front of the historic town hall. The project is the key to the development of the location and is of considerable importance to urban planning in Chemnitz. The camber of the building's curved roof reacts to the diversity of the area and the eaves heights of the adjacent buildings.
